1m 5 stops

Tracker/mechanical action

*Compass* CC to e4

*Dimensions*

Width 6ft

Depth 3 ft

Height 10ft

*Stop List* (no pitch engravings)

LHS

Coupler Rod severed. Original function unknown.

Stop Diapason (8 ft)

Open Diapason (8 ft) No bottom octave

RHS

Fifteenth (2 ft)

Twelfth (2 2/3 ft) TC

Principal (4 ft)

Two broad metal foot pedals

RH draws stops on RH jamb

LH withdraws stops on RH jamb

Pumping handle fixture in place on left side of case.

No pumping handle.

Small (1/4 HP?) electric motor/blower unit (Watkins & Watson?).

Bellows double rise, inverted fold with two wedge feeder bellows beneath

Keyboard in good condition. Little wear. Perhaps not original?

Case Pitchpine

Keyboard surrounds and jambs Mahogany?

Metal pipes are of lead. Many have sagged.



Open Diapason has tuning slides. Remainder are without slides.

Display pipes half round wood.

Unsymmetric pipe planting

The instrument came from Barrow, nr. Chester, about 25 years ago.



This chamber organ has charm. Stop Diapason especially winning – broad in the bass; warm, gently clear elsewhere. Open Diapason rich and stringy. Principal and Fifteenth bright yet reserved. Twelfth well integrated. Tutti restrained strength and depth - with clarity.
